What We're Learning!



Math: In math next week we will focus on multiplication and division. We will review for our unit one test on Wednesday and test on Thursday.

"I can represent multiplication facts using equal sized groups."

"I can represent division using equal sharing and forming equal groups."

Reading: In reading this week we will continue our work on literature through the study of fairy tales and folk tales this week.

"I can retell fairy tales and folktales using details from the text to find the central message."

Social Studies: Students will learn that **history** is the study of the past, that **ancient** means very old, and that a **civilization** is a group of people living and working together in a well organized way. We will learn about the civilizations of Ancient Egypt, Ancient Rome, and Ancient China. We will study history to see that people who lived long ago were like us in many ways, and different from us in other ways.
