The Purpose:

To expand your reading comfort zone and explore new genres
To encourage a love for reading by enthusiastically reading books of your own choice
To develop an understanding of story elements, text features and text structures

The Rules:

- Each book must be read by YOU! The books should be at your level.
- Books must be a minimum of 50 pages. Picture books do not qualify.
- Books that are 300 pages or longer can count as two books.
- Record each book in the "30 Book Challenge" record sheet.
- Books must meet the genre requirements but do not need to be read in any specific order

Poetry - 2
Realistic Fiction - 6
Historical Fiction - 2
Fantasy - 4
Mystery - 4
Informational -2
Biography/Autobiography - 2
Chapter Books of your choice- 8

The 30 Book Challenge is from "The Book Whisperer" written by Donalyn Miller. She is a 6th grade teacher from Texas. Her book reveals the secrets of turning every student into a vibrant reader!
